

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Jonesboro, Louisiana met in a legally called special session at their regular meeting place, the City Hall, 128 Allen Avenue, Jonesboro, Louisiana at 12 o'clock noon.

Mayor Essmeier called the meeting to order and Mr. Stringer led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mr. Shows gave the Invocation.

The roll was called and the following members were present:

Mayor Essmeier asked for the reading of the Call.

Motion by Mr. Shows, second Mrs. Zuber declaring that an emergency situation exists in the Police Department after an accident which resulted in the loss of a police unit and a new unit should be purchased as soon as possible. All voted in favor and the emergency was declared.

Motion by Mr. Layfield, second Mrs. Zuber to purchase a new police vehicle from Pineland Ford who has a 2004 Ford Crown Victoria with the Police Interceptor Package for the cost of \$20,362.63 available now, if ordered it will take approximately 2 – 3 months for delivery. All voted in favor to purchase the vehicle from Pineland Ford.

Motion by Mr. Layfield, second Mr. Stringer approving repairs on the City Hall building, which consists of the replacement of the columns at the drive-through, replacing and painting some rotting boards at the drive-through and painting the columns on the front of City Hall. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Shows, second Mrs. Zuber. All voted in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
