Motion by Mrs. Zuber, second Mr. Shows to adopt Resolution #981, in support of the grant application submitted to the Governor's Office of Rural Development Fund to replace pumps and controls in the Cynthia Street Lift Station. All voted in favor and resolution was duly adopted.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Layfield, second Mr. Shows. All voted in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
